Help Guide: Using ETDM Project Map Services



OVERVIEW

The Efficient Transportation Decision Making (ETDM) process is Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT's) procedure for reviewing qualifying transportation projects to consider potential environmental effects in the Planning phase. This process provides stakeholders the opportunity for early input, involvement, and coordination. It helps identify potential project effects and informs the development of scopes for projects advancing to the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) phase.

This early coordination is facilitated through the Environmental Screening Tool (EST), an Internet-accessible interactive database and mapping application. The web site makes information available about proposed transportation projects, agency comments on a variety of environmental and sociocultural topics associated with those projects, and various documents describing the ETDM Process. The website can be accessed at https://etdmpub.fla-etat.org/est/.

The ETDM project map services are also available for people to use in their own Geographic Information System (GIS) software.

WHERE CAN I GET MAP SERVICES WITH ETDM PROJECTS IN THE EST?

The ETDM project features are available in three feature map services (REST endpoints):

- Projects currently seeking comments in an active review
- Projects that were previously reviewed
- · Alternatives that have been eliminated

- 2) Select Data from Path
- 3) Paste the REST endpoint URL and click Add
